After two and a half years of pandemic isolation, IWC's first in-person concert as a full chorus in May 2022 was a joyous celebration of hope in the acoustically wonderful Christel DeHaan Fine Arts Center! We premiered the beautiful "In the Wistful Heart of Night" by local composer Miho Sasaki. It was the culmination of our 2021-2022 season, a year aptly described by our season theme – **Tending, Turning, Transforming.**

We tended to our cumulative need for joy, comfort, and healing by rehearsing in person together and sharing our music with others.









We welcomed 26 new members, as well as those who had joined IWC during the pandemic and had only known Zoom rehearsals.

We shared in the joy of the season by offering holiday carols at "Christmas as the Zoo," an Indy Choral Collaborative project.

We created a November 2022 video around the song "We Shall Be Known" as a virtual gift to our audiences, with over 800 views. We set out on a journey to understand, and to turn away from those things that could keep us from becoming a more inclusive and accessible chorus, where more singers and audiences feel like they belong. Consultants from Kindred Collective helped guide us through sometimes difficult but always valuable conversations about who we are and how we live out our mission and values.
